A variety of warm up & main creative exercises are then completed, where Rhianne will also provide professional guidance, tips & creative techniques to help develop creative skills & confidence.

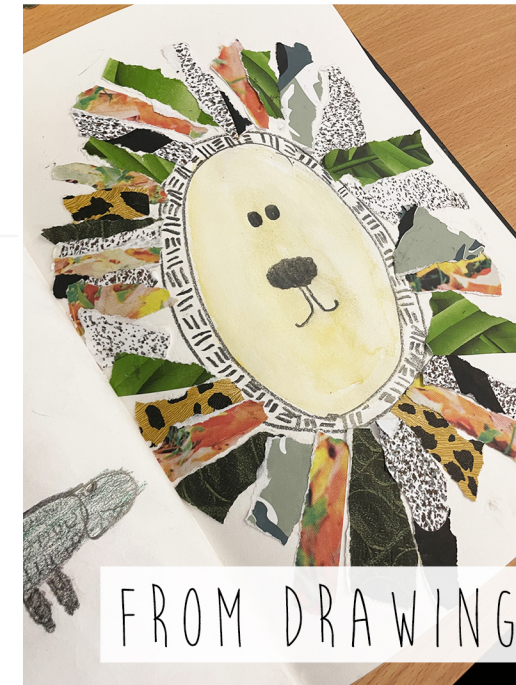
